Dear Parents and Guardians,

In June 2011, the Vermont Department of Education identified Rutland Middle School as a priority school in need of improvement based on students' performance on the state assessment. Our school did not make Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) in Reading or Mathematics within the sub-group of students who receive Free and Reduced Lunch. The state will be providing technical assistance and some additional funding to support our continuing improvement efforts.

RMS is continually working to improve instruction and outcomes for **all** students. We continue school and district-wide initiatives in literacy, mathematics and professional development. These initiatives are part of our continuous internal process of analyzing our strengths and weaknesses and then taking action to improve.

As a result of this most recent AYP determination, our school must offer services beyond the school day to students eligible for Free and Reduced Lunch who have a need for academic help. These services are called supplemental education services (SES). Supplemental service is defined as additional instruction for students who are eligible and would benefit in an effort to meet their academic goals. Students who qualify for free and reduced lunch and who are not meeting the school expectations for achievement qualify for supplemental services. Individuals and groups that have been approved for this purpose by the Vermont Department of Education (VTDOE) can provide the services. The cost of this service will be paid for by the school district.
